

Third Sector Representation Elections: June 2010

We are seeking nominations for the following positions:

DtS Board (1 Place)

DtS is the Local Strategic Partnership for Doncaster. It is dedicated to improving the quality of life for those who live, work and visit the borough. At its head is the DtS Board, which brings together public sector, voluntary and community organisations and local business so it can discuss the key issues which affect Doncaster and agree on ways forward. Its key objectives are to:

1. Develop the vision and priorities for Doncaster through the Sustainable Borough Strategy (SBS); and
2. Agree the delivery plan and detailed outcomes for development of the area through the Local Area Agreement (LAA).

The board is chaired by the Mayor and includes the Police Chief Superintendent and the Chief Executives of Doncaster Council and NHS Doncaster, as well as senior representatives from organisations including SYPTTE, Doncaster Chamber, Doncaster College and Doncaster CVS.

You will be the elected third sector representative on the board.

The board's current work plan includes driving forward improvements across the Local Area Agreement and particularly the following 5 key priorities that the board has identified: harm caused by alcohol misuse; child poverty; work and skills; housing; perception, reputation and satisfaction.

The DtS Board currently meets approximately every six weeks.
